

STAY SAFE.... STAY OFF THE RAILWAY



The electrified rail and overhead wires have electricity in them. It is very **dangerous** and the electricity is **always switched on**.



A train travelling at 125mph can take up to 2000 metres to stop in an emergency – that's the length of 20 football pitches.



The yellow line on a platform is to **warn you** that trains pass at high speed so **never cross the yellow line** until your train has come into the station and stopped.



An average train weighs **400 tonnes** which is equal to **80 large elephants**.



No trespassing

Do not go on the railway it is **very dangerous**.



Understand the warning signs at level crossings (lights, barriers, alarms). **STOP LOOK LISTEN** when using level crossings.
