STAY SAFE.... STAY OFF THE RAILWAY



The electrified rail and overhead wires have electricity in them. It is very dangerous and the electricity is always switched on.



A train travelling at 125mph can take up to 2000 metres to stop in an emergency – that's the length of 20 football pitches.



The yellow line on a platform is to warn you that trains pass at high speed so never cross the yellow line until your train has come into the station and stopped.



An average train weighs
400 tonnes which is equal to
80 large elephants.



Do not go on the railway it is **very dangerous**.



Understand the warning signs at level crossings (lights, barriers, alarms). **STOP LOOK LISTEN** when using level crossings.
