### How the Logo Mark has evolved to fit our vision



- "Bar' shapes of the old Logo Mark were used as inspiration to create a new coloured 'temperature range bar'
- Colours are bright, modern and represent the 5 temperature values that we deliver on: -80°C, -60°C, -21°C, +5°C, +21°C

 The coloured bars were then merged to create a solid square shape to contain the new Logo Mark

- New contemporary font
- Capitalised company name to illustrate robustness & strength
- New blue to match the external paint colour of our containers
- Removal of the word 'solutions' – We don't just offer a solution, our containers are backed up by world-class customer services
- New Logo Mark created as a stand-alone, recognisable element to represent the Tower brand
- Logo Mark combines the letters TCC (Tower Cold Chain), shaped into a 3 dimensional box which represents our containers







### **Logo Size and Exclusion Zone**

To maintain visibility and legibility the Tower Cold Chain Logo Mark must never be smaller than 30mm in width. Sufficient space must also be left around the Logo Mark to ensure it is clearly visible at all times and free from obstruction.



The minimum amount of clear space around all sides of the Logo Mark should be equal to, or greater than, the height of the 'T' in TOWER



Minimum Size: 30mm

### **Logo Application**

Wherever possible, the full colour Tower Cold Chain Logo Mark (Primary Logo Mark) must be used and always on a white background. Only in situations or applications where use of the Primary Logo Mark is not possible, the alternatives listed below may be used at the discretion and under supervision of the Tower Brand Manager.

### **Preferred Logo Placement**

Wherever possible, the Tower Logo Mark must always be placed in the top left hand corner of a document to ensure consistency across the brand.



#### Lorem Ipsum

In publishing and graphic design, Lorem ipsum is a placeholder text commonly used to demonstrate the visual form of a document or a typeface without relying on meaningful content. Lorem ipsum may be used as a placeholder before final copy is available. It is also used to temporarily replace text in a process called greeking, which allows designers to consider the form of a webpage or publication, without the meaning of the text influencing the design.

Lorem ipsum is typically a corrupted version of 'De finibus bonorum et malorum', a 1st century BC text by the Roman statesman and philosopher Cicero, with words altered, added, and removed to make it nonsensical and improper Latin.

Versions of the Lorem ipsum text have been used in typesetting at least since the 1960s, when it was popularized by advertisements for Letraset transfer sheets. [1] Lorem ipsum was introduced to the digital world in the mid-1980s, when Aldus employed it in graphic and word-processing templates for its desktop publishing program PageMaker. Other popular word processors, including Pages and Microsoft Word, have since adopted Lorem ipsum. [2] as have many LaTeX packages. [3] [4] [5] web content managers such as Joomlal and WordPress, and CSS libraries such as Semantic UI.[6]

#### Source text[edit]

The Lorem ipsum text is derived from sections 1.10.32 and 1.10.33 of Cicero's 'De finibus bonorum et malorum'.[7] [8] The physical source may have been the 1914 Loeb Classical Library edition of De finibus, where the Latin text, presented on the left-hand (even) pages, breaks off on page 34 with "Neque porro quisquam est qui do-" and continues on page 36 with "lorem ipsum ...", suggesting that the galley type of that page was mixed up to make the dummy text seen today.[1]

The discovery of the text's origin is attributed to Richard McClintock, a Latin scholar at Hampden-Sydney College. McClintock connected Lorem ipsum to Cicero's writing sometime before 1982 while searching for instances of the Latin word consectetur, which was rarely used in classical literature.[2] McClintock first published his discovery in a 1994 letter to the editor of Before & After magazine, contesting the editor's earlier claim that Lorem ipsum held no meaning.[2]

...position the logo directly on top of an image






...add borders or shapes behind the logo






...place the signature at an angle


### **Copywriting Guidelines**


- When referring to our company name in copy, the word Tower should always be written in Title Case, not capital letters
- · Always use the full product naming convention when referring to our containers, with the container name in Rubik Medium and the supporting copy in Rubik Regular. e.g. KTM32 Tower US Pallet
- · Container naming conventions are as follows:
- KTM21 Tower "Low" Euro Pallet
- KTM31 Tower "Low" US Pallet
- KTM22 Tower Euro Pallet
- KTM32 Tower US Pallet
- KTM42 Tower Double Euro Pallet
- KTM42D Tower Double Euro Pallet Ultra Cold
- KTM52 Tower Double US Pallet
- KT400 Tower Flexi Fit
- KT400D Tower Flexi Fit Ultra Cold
- Don't use abbreviations in copy
