Interpretation
In these Conditions: 'BUYER' means the person who accepts a quotation of the Seller for the sale of the Goods or whose order for the Goods is accepted by the Seller.
'GOODS' means the goods (including any instalment of the goods or any parts for them) which the Seller is to supply in accordance with these conditions.
'SELLER' means Limelight Publicity (registered in England & Wales under number 5034718)
'CONDITIONS' means the standard terms and conditions of sale set out in this document and (unless the context otherwise requires) includes any special terms and conditions agreed in writing between the Buyer and the Seller.
'CONTRACT' means the contract for the purchase and sale of the goods.
Any reference to these Conditions to any provision of a statute shall be construed as a reference to that provision as amended or extended at the relevant time.
This Agreement and the supply of the Goods is governed by The Supply of Goods and Services Act 1982.
Any reference to the singular shall also impart the plural and any reference to the masculine shall also impart the feminine.
Basis of the Sale
The Seller shall supply and the Buyer shall purchase the Goods in accordance with any written quotation of the Seller which is accepted by the Buyer, or any written order of the Buyer which is accepted by the Seller, subject in either case, to the exclusion of any other terms and conditions subject to which any such quotation is accepted or purported to be accepted, or any such order is made or purported to be made, by the Buyer.
No variation to these Conditions shall be binding unless agreed in writing between the authorised representatives of the Buyer and the Seller.
The Seller's employees or agents are not authorised to make any representations concerning the Goods unless confirmed by the Seller in writing, in entering into the Contract the Buyer acknowledges that it does not rely on, and waives any claim for breach of representations which are not so confirmed.
Any advice or recommendation given by the Seller or its employees or agents to the Buyer or its employees or agents as to the storage or application or use of the Goods which is not confirmed in writing by the Seller is followed or acted upon at the Buyer's sole risk, and accordingly the Seller shall not be liable for any such advice or recommendation which is not so confirmed.
Any typographical, clerical or other error or omission in any sales literature, quotation, price list, acceptance of offer, invoice or other document or information issued by the Seller shall be subject to correction without any liability to the Seller.
Orders and Specifications
No order submitted by the Buyer shall be deemed to be accepted by the Seller unless and until confirmed either in writing or verbally by the Seller or (if earlier) the Seller delivers the goods to the Buyer or commences performance of the services.
The Buyer shall be responsible to the Seller for ensuring the accuracy of the terms of any order (including any applicable specification) submitted by the Buyer, and for giving the Seller any necessary information relating to the goods to be supplied.
The quantity, quality and description of and any specification for the Goods shall be those set out in the Seller's quotation (if accepted by the Buyer) or the Buyer's order (if accepted by the Seller).
If the Goods are to be manufactured or any process is to be applied to the Goods by the Seller in accordance with a specification submitted by the Buyer, the Buyer shall indemnify the Seller against all loss, damages, costs and expenses awarded against the Seller in connection with or paid or agreed to be paid by the Seller in settlement of any claim for infringement of any patent, copyright, design, trade mark or other industrial or intellectual property rights of any other person which arises out of the Buyer's specification.
The Seller reserves the right to make any changes in the specification of the Goods which are required to conform with any applicable statutory or EC requirements or, where the Goods are to be supplied to the Seller's specification, which affect the quantity, quality or performance.
No order which has been accepted by the Seller may be cancelled by the Buyer except with the agreement in writing of the Seller and on terms that the Buyer shall indemnify the Seller in full against all loss (including the loss of profit, costs of labour and materials used), damages, charges an expenses incurred by the Seller as a result of the cancellation.
Price of the goods
The price of the Goods shall be the Seller's quoted price or, where no price has been quoted (or a quoted price is no longer valid), the price listed in the Seller's published price list current at the date of acceptance of the order.
The Seller reserves the right, by giving notice to the Buyer at any time before delivery, to increase the price of the Goods to reflect any increase in the cost to the Seller which is due to any factor beyond control of the Seller (such as a change in exchange rate, fluctuation, currency regulation, alteration of duties, significant increase in the costs of labour, materials or other costs of manufacture), any change in delivery dates, quantities or specifications for the Goods which is requested by the Buyer, or any change in the Seller's instructions of the Buyer or failure of the Buyer to give the Seller adequate information or instructions.
Except as otherwise stated under the terms of any quotation or in any price list of the Seller, and unless otherwise agreed in writing between the Buyer and the Seller, all prices are given by the Seller on a basis where the Seller agrees to deliver the Goods otherwise than at the Seller's premises, the Buyer shall be liable to pay the Seller's charges for transport, packaging and insurance.
The price is exclusive of any applicable value added tax, which the Buyer shall be additionally liable to pay to the Seller.
Terms of Payment
Subject to any special terms agreed in writing between the Buyer and the Seller, the Seller shall be entitled to invoice the Buyer for the price of the Goods on or at any time after delivery of the Goods, unless the Goods are to be collected by the Buyer, in which case the Seller shall be entitled to invoice the Buyer for the price at any time after the Seller has notified the Buyer that the Goods are ready for collection or (as the case may be) the Seller has delivered the Goods.
Subject to any special terms agreed in writing between the Buyer and the Seller, the buyer shall pay the price of the Goods (but without any other deduction) within 30 days of the date for the Seller's invoice, and the Seller shall be entitled to withhold delivery until payment in full has been received by the Seller.
If the Buyer fails to make any payment of the due date then, without prejudice to any other right or remedy available to the Seller, the Seller shall be entitled to:
Cancel the contract or suspend any further deliveries
Appropriate payment made by the Buyer to such of the Goods (or the goods supplied under any other contract between the Buyer and the Seller) as the Seller may think fit (notwithstanding any appropriation by the Buyer; and charge the Buyer interest (both before and after any judgement) on the amount unpaid, at the rate of 5% per annum above HSBC Bank base rate from time to time, until payment in full is made (a part of a month being treated as a full month for the purposes of interest).
Delivery
Delivery of the Goods shall be made by the Buyer collecting the Goods at the Seller's premises at any time after the Seller has notified the Buyer that the Goods are ready for collection, or if some other place for delivery is agreed by the Seller, at that place.
While every effort will be made by the Seller to effect delivery in accordance with any agreed dates quote for delivery of the Goods are approximate only and the Seller shall not be liable for any delay in delivery of the Goods howsoever caused. Time for delivery shall not be of the essence unless previously agreed by the Seller in writing. The Goods may be delivered by the Seller in advance of the quoted delivery date.
Where delivery of the Goods is made by the Seller in bulk, the Seller reserves the right to deliver up to 5% more or 5% less than the quantity ordered without any adjustment in the price and the quantity so delivered shall be the quantity deemed ordered, and therefore the Goods shall be invoiced for accordingly.
Where the Goods are to be delivered in instalments, each delivery shall constitute a separate contract and failure by the Seller to deliver any one or more of the instalments in accordance with these Conditions or any claim by the Buyer in respect of any instalment shall not entitle the Buyer to treat the Contract as a whole as repudiated.
If the Seller fails to deliver the Goods for any reason other than any cause beyond the Seller's reasonable control or the Buyer's fault, and the Seller is accordingly liable to the Buyer, the Seller's liability shall be limited to the cost of the Goods (in the cheapest available market) of similar goods to replace those not delivered over the price of the Goods.
If the Buyer fails to take delivery of the Goods or fails to give the Seller adequate delivery instructions at the time stated for delivery (otherwise than by reason of any cause beyond the Buyer's reasonable control or by reason of the Seller's fault), the Seller may:
store the Goods until actual delivery and charge the Buyer for the reasonable costs (including insurance) of storage;
sell the Goods at the best price readily obtainable and (after deducting all reasonable storage and selling expenses) account to the Buyer for the excess over the price under the Contract or charge the Buyer for any shortfall below that price under the Contract.
For the avoidance of doubt the reasonable costs referred to in clause 6.6.1 will include charges made by the Seller's Carriage firms for storage and extra delivery costs.
Risk and Property
Risk of damage to or loss of the Goods shall pass to the Buyer.
In the case of Goods to be delivered at the Seller's premises, at the time when the Seller notifies the Buyer that the Goods are available for collection; or
In the case of Goods being delivered otherwise than at the Seller's premises, at the time of delivery or, if the Buyer wrongfully fails to take delivery of the Goods, the time when the Seller has tendered delivery of the Goods.
Notwithstanding delivery and the passing of risk in the Goods, or any other provision of these Conditions, the property in the Goods shall not pass to the Buyer until the Seller has received in cash or cleared funds payment in full of the price of the Goods agreed to be sold by the Seller to the Buyer for which payment is then due.
Until such time as the property in the Goods passes to the Buyer, the Buyer shall hold the Goods as the Seller's fiduciary agent and bailee, they shall keep the goods separate from those of the Buyer and third parties and property stored, protected and insured as the Seller's property. Until that time the Buyer shall be entitled to resell or use the goods in the ordinary course of its business, but shall account to the Seller for the proceeds of sale or otherwise of the goods, whether tangible or intangible, proceeds, and shall keep all such proceeds separate from any moneys or property of the Buyer and third parties and, in the case of tangible proceeds, properly stored, protected and insured.
Until such time as the property in the Goods passes to the Buyer (and provided the Goods are still in existence and have not been resold), the Seller shall be entitled at any time to required the Buyer to delivery up the Goods to the Seller and, if the Buyer fails to do so, to enter upon any premises of the Buyer or any third party where the Goods are stored and repossess the Goods.
The Buyer shall not be entitled to pledge or in any way charge by way of security for any indebtedness any of the Goods which remain the property of the Seller, but if the Buyer does so all moneys owing by the Buyer to the Seller shall (without prejudice to any other remedy of the Seller) forth with become due and payable.
Warranties and Liability
Subject to the conditions set out below the Seller warrants to use reasonable skill and care with regards to any design portion and specification as agreed in the supplier's quotation and/or the purchase order.
The above warranty is given by the Seller subject to the following conditions:
The Seller shall be under no liability in respect of any defect in the Goods arising from any drawing, design or specification supplied by the Buyer and shall not be responsible for verifying the adequacy thereof.
The Seller shall be under no liability in respect of any defect arising from fair wear and tear, wilful damage, negligence, abnormal working conditions, failure to follow the Seller's instructions (whether oral or in writing), misuse or the Goods without the Seller's approval.
The Seller shall be under no liability under the above warranty (or any other warranty, condition or guarantee) if the total price for the Goods has not been paid by the due date for payment.
The above warranty does not extend to parts, materials or equipment not manufactured by the Seller, in respect of which the Buyer shall only be entitled to the benefit of any such warranty or guarantee as is given by the manufacturer to the Seller.
The Seller accepts no responsibility for the consequences of combining the Seller's products with other products or for the consequences or repacking the Seller's products.
Subject as expressly provided in these Conditions, and where except where the Goods are sold to a person dealing as a consumer (within the meaning of the Unfair Contract Terms Act 1977), all warranties, conditions or other terms implied by statute or common law to the fullest extent permitted by law.
Where the Goods are sold under a consumer transaction (as defined by the Consumer Transactions (Restrictions on Statements) Order 1976 the statutory rights of the Buyer are not affected by these Conditions.
Any claim by the Buyer which is based on any defect in the quality of condition of the Goods or their failure to correspond with specification shall (whether or not delivery is refused by the Buyer) be notified to the Seller within 7 days from the date of delivery or, if the Goods are not delivered, the date of the Seller's notification of the defect or failure, and the Buyer shall not be entitled to reject the Goods and the Seller shall have no liability for such defect or failure, and the Buyer shall be bound to pay the price as if the Goods had been delivered with the Contract.
Where any valid claim in respect of any of the Goods which is based on any defect in the quality or condition of the Goods or their failure to meet specification is notified to the Seller in accordance with these Conditions, the Seller shall be obliged to (or the part in question) free of charge.
Except in respect of death or personal injury caused by the Seller's negligence, the Seller shall not be liable to the Buyer by reason of any representation, or any implied warranty, condition or other term, or any duty or common law or under the Contract, for any consequential loss or damage (whether for loss of profit or otherwise), costs, expenses or other claims for consequential compensation whatsoever and whether caused by the negligence of the Seller, its employees or agents or otherwise, which arises out with the supply of the Goods or their use or resale by the Buyer, except as expressly provided in these Conditions.
The Seller shall not be liable to the Buyer or be deemed to be in breach of the Contract by reason of any delay in performing, or any failure to perform, any of the Seller's obligations in relation to the Goods, if the delay or failure was caused by the Seller's reasonable control. Without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing, the following shall be regarded as causes beyond the Seller's reasonable control;
Fire, lightning, explosion, storm or severe weather, flood or escape of water, earthquake or other natural disaster.
Act or threat of war and/or terrorism, riot, civil commotion, insurrection and any nuclear or toxic incident.
Acts, restrictions, regulations, laws, prohibitions or measures of any kind on the part of any governmental, parliamentary or local authority;
Import or export regulations or embargoes;
Strikes, lockouts or other industrial actions or trade disputes (whether involving employees of the Seller or of a third party);
Difficulties in obtaining raw materials, labour, fuel, parts or machinery;
Power failure or breakdown in machinery
Any consequence caused by Coronavirus Covid-19 or any other national or global pandemic including but not limited to unavailability of labour and/or materials.
Indemnity
If any claim is made against the Buyer that the Goods infringe or that their use or resale infringes the patent, copyright, design, trade mark or other industrial or intellectual property rights of any other person, it is agreed that the Seller is given full control of any proceedings or negotiations in connection with such claim;
